Gatchina Palace Hosts the Annual Event of the Programme

On 3-4 June 2014 the Annual Event of the Programme "Joint solutions for the benefit of the Estonia-Latvia-Russia border area" to be held in the Gatchina Palace, Gatchina, Leningrad region, Russia. Event will focus on the Programme support to socio – economic development on near border regions. Project exhibition "Children in project focus" will take place in Gatchina palace and thematic Fact Sheet of the Programme highlights the results of capitalization of children related projects and activities. The year 2014 is announced 'the Year of Children' by the Governor of the Leningrad Region.

Projects Finalising its Planned Activities

Following three 1st Open Call Projects have closed its planned activities in May 2014.

Two bilateral cross border cooperation projects have promoted the **People to people cooperation**. Project "Reduction of social consequences of an HIV spread in Estonia and Leningrad region of Russia" ("Helping to live"), implemented between Estonia and Russia, has developed the sociopsychological support system for people living with HIV/AIDS in border territories of Estonia and Leningrad region. **2 social support centres were established** - 1 in Narva and 1 in St.Petersburg for the target group and various trainings arranged for the staff of the support centres as well seminars for the social workers of local municipalities, non-profit organisations and medical institutions of Leningrad region and North-East Estonia. Exchange of best practices between specialists of two countries has been arranged in order to provide **professional support** for the people living with HIV/AIDS.

Cooperation project between Estonia and Russia "Cross country through football" (CCF) has improved the sport facilities in Narva, Estonia and Pechory, Russia and contributed to the intercultural dialogue through sports. As a result of the cross-border cooperation there were 2 football grounds reconstructed- 1 in Narva and 1 in Pechory, trainings of football trainers, judges arranged. Around 600 matches and 4 weekly sport camps for children were organised during the 2 years.

CBC project "Integrated Intelligent Platform for Monitoring the Cross-Border Natural-Technological Systems" ("INFORM") between Latvia and Russia, under the Programme Priority Common challenges has developed a universal common intelligent platform in order to unify efforts of specialists from Russia and Latvia to protect the environment, based on integrated spaceground monitoring. The project addressed the topical problem of integrated real-time monitoring and control of cross-border natural-technological systems in normal and emergency situations based on heterogeneous data received from space and ground-based facilities.

Strategy of Estonia-Russia Programme Discussed in Tallinn

On May 17th 2014, a **Programme Workshop** for the new Estonia-Russia Programme 2014-2020 took place in Tallinn, Estonia. The workshop, led and moderated by INTERACT, focused on the **challenges and priorities of the next Programme period**. The results of the one-day event are integrated into the Joint Operational Programme and will be presented at the next meeting of the Joint Programming Committee of Estonia-Russia Programme in June 2014.
