On 3 August 2013 during celebration of the 86th anniversary of Leningrad region the Governor of the Region Alexandr Drozdenko announced the year 2014 to be the Year of Childhood in the Leningrad region.

That is why it was decided to announce the coming 2014 year "The Year of Childhood" in the Leningrad region." - said the Governor in his

Within the frame of the Year of Childhood the regional authorities in cooperation with public and non-commercial organizations, business and media are arranging public events directed towards development of support of children and families.

State Committee for Education and State Committee for Social Care of the Leningrad region are arranging festivals of creative works, sports events, and public awareness actions aimed at supporting talented children, families with children having special needs, foster families and families at social risk, assisting general and vocational education of youth.

The Administration of Leningrad region also continues taking part in implementation of state programs and assisting in the work of charitable institutions, providing support to children and youth.

The issue of support to children and youth and families with children in the spheres of sport, education, social rehabilitation and adaptation are also among the key priorities of the states of the EU. Thus Estonia-Latvia-Russia CBC Programme responded and integrated the thematic of children and youth support into the topics of the Annual Event of the Programme, hosted in the year 2014 by Gatchina, Leningrad Region.


Among the Programme Priorities or Measures there is no directly formulated assistance to children or families, but due to its evident importance for all the stakeholders of the Programme in the wider border territory of Estonia, Latvia and Russia many projects support children. Over 10 000 children are benefiting from the cooperation between three countries in the frame of the cross border cooperation participating in 24 out of 50 projects supported by the Programme.

9 of the projects of the Estonia-Latvia Russia CBC Programme are directly connected with children support having families and children as their final beneficiaries. Measures represented here are

- 3.2 Cooperation in spheres of culture, sport, education, social and health;
- 1.1 Fostering of socio-economic development and encouraging business and entrepreneurship;
- 2.1 Joint actions aimed at protection of environment and natural resources;
- 2.3 Improvement of energy efficiency and promotion of renewable energy sources.

Over 10 000 children are benefiting In at least 44 locations all over Programme territory project partners work for children support. In Latvia 19 places - Rēzekne, Dagda, Daugavpils, Līvāni, Vilāni, Kārsava, Krāslava, Lipuški, Malnava, Preili, Ilūkste, Valka, Valmiera, from the cooperation between Estonia, Smiltene, Sigulda, Līgatne, Salacgrīva, Ķemeriand and Rīga. In Estonia 9 places - Avinurme, Tartu, Narva, Voru, Meremae, Poltsamaa, Johvi, Valga, Rouge. 16 places in Russia - Vyborg, Pskov, Pechory, Ostrov, Palkino, Sebezh, Novoe Devyatkino, Shlisselburg, Kingisepp, Porhov, St. Petersburg, Volhov, Gatchina, Krasnogordsk, Pytalovo, Gdov.

Approximately **5 million EURO** are invested by the Programme into children support through projects directly related to children

Latvia and Russia.
