## Results

Increased number of speech therapists in Estonia and Russia ready to give high quality assistance to children and grown-ups with speech problems

Approximately 40 people get speech therapy and assistance every year by each of trained specialists, in total 2200 people get better therapy results after the project implementation

**Increased average results** of secondary and high school graduates in Estonian language exams

Cooperation network between Estonia and Russia in the field of special education is developed

The base for development of **new common curriculum in speech therapy** for using both in Estonia and Russia is made . This makes possible high quality special education after project lifetime, further development of **exchange study programs** between partner educational institutions.

Speech specialists and students of both countries are informed about speech therapy best practices, new trends and project achievements through publications in specialized magazines, Brochure, Leaflets.
